THROUGHOUT HIS CAREER, Dale Hatfield has touched the lives of thousands of students and professionals involved in telecommunications and embodied the ideal of rigorously thoughtful technology policy analysis in the private sector, academia, and government. Over his distinguished career in the public sector, he served as Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology, Chief Technologist and Chief of the Office of Plans & Policy at the Federal Communications Commission and as Assistant Secretary of Commerce and Administrator of the National Telecommunications and Information Administration. Professor Hatfield's many honors include: the Department of Commerce Silver Medal for contributions to domestic communications satellite policy, the Attorney General's Distinguished Service Award, and the FCC's Gold Medal Award for Distinguished Service. In 2008, Dale was awarded an honorary degree by the University of Colorado.

TO RECOGNIZE AND HONOR DALE HATFIELD'S LEGACY, in 2005, the University of Colorado created the Dale Hatfield Scholars and Research Program to promote and carry on the values that Dale has embodied in his distinguished career. The Hatfield Program has already made an impact through its support of CU's emerging Policy Lab project (which evaluates technology policy issues for policymakers) and has funded student internships in government and public interest organizations (including at the FCC, the FTC, Public Knowledge, and NENA). The Program has also supported the Flatirons Summits on Information Policy, which bring together leaders in academia, industry, government, and non-profits to evaluate novel solutions to information policy challenges.
